TTDC Recognized among the "White 500" for the Fifth Time under the 2023 Certified Health & Productivity Management Outstanding Organizations Recognition Program

On March 8, 2023 Toyota Technical Development Corporation (TTDC, Head Office: Toyota, Aichi, President: Yoshiyuki Kagawa) was recognized for a fifth time as a "White 500" company in the large enterprise category of the 2023 Certified Health & Productivity Management Outstanding Organizations Recognition Program designed by the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, and run by the Nippon Kenko Kaigi.

TTDC continues to regard employee health as a core corporate management issue for achieving further sustainable growth and development, and is working to promote the health of our employees and their families. We have introduced various measures to reduce the increasing number of people diagnosed with potential issues in their annual health checkups since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, including holding events encouraging employees to re-examine their lifestyle habits via a smart phone app and an online course to improve sleep literacy. We have complemented these efforts with measures to facilitate the careers of diverse groups of employees, such as establishing a new special leave system for people undergoing fertility treatment and online courses about women's health issues. Through these measures, we are aiming to support and promote a corporate environment in which our employees and their families can continue working with even greater peace of mind.

This "White 500" certification in the 2023 Certified Health & Productivity Management Outstanding Organizations Recognition Program gives us further impetus to continue actively practicing health-oriented management that ties into our basic vision and its emphasis of employee happiness and respect for the diversity of our team members.
